TLIF2080 Safely Access the Rail Corridor



Course (Duration 1 day)

TLIF2080 Safely Access the Rail Corridor is a mandatory requirement for **all** contractors working within Transport for New South Wales (TfNSW), Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) and Country Rail Network (CRN) rail corridors.

It provides awareness of legal obligations, critical safety requirements and hazards that workers must be able to identify and deal with when conducting contracts inside the rail corridor.

Medical

All contractors working on the railway must pass a health assessment to confirm they are fit to carry out such work.

Medicals are only accepted if they are performed by a TfNSW Approved Practitioner. The minimum requirement is a Category 3 medical which includes:

- drug & alcohol testing
- hearing, vision and mobility testing

Requirements

- Category 3 Medical
- 100 points of identification
- Must be able to read, write, understand and speak English
- Must be over the age of 17 years old

Location

Assessment

Students must pass a written (*closed book*) and practical assessment to be deemed competent
