

ROAD RAIL PLANT OPERATOR (TMO)



Course Description

This nationally accredited course is designed to provide hands-on training to drivers and operators of:

- Hi-rail plant and equipment
- Road/rail vehicles (4-wheel drives & trucks)

Participants will learn the requirements, rules and procedures applicable when performing tasks during a *work on track authority (LPA/TWA/TOA)*.

One (1) day, face to face training

Vehicle

Training can be completed using:

- SCRT supplied **manual** road/rail vehicle
- Your own road/rail certified vehicle (if preferred)

Assessment

To be deemed competent, all participants must successfully complete:

- Theory Written Assessment
- Practical Assessment, undertaken at nearby sidings.

Recertification

Recertification is every 5 years and consists of a half-day theory course before card expiry date with a current medical.

Dress Code

Full rail PPE required on the day of training including:

- Long sleeve orange hi-vis shirt
- Steel cap safety boots
- Hard hat
- Long trousers

Requirements

- Current RIW Card
- Category One (1) Medical
- White Card
- Current Driver's License for the type of vehicle you will be driving.
- Competency or ticket for the plant item you will be operating.

Outcome

Successful participants will receive a Statement of Attainment for the following national units:

- **TLIC3045 Operate road/rail vehicle**
- **TLIC2054 Access rail track to run track vehicle within a defined worksite**
